**COMPLAINT FOR PATENT
INFRINGEMENT**

17 Plaintiff Medicis Pharmaceutical Corporation (“Medicis”) alleges:

18 **JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

19 1. This action arises under the Declaratory Judgment Act and the Patent
20 Statute of the United States of America, Titles 28 and 35 of United States Code, and
21 jurisdiction is founded on Title 28, United States Code §§ 2201(a), 1331, and 1338(a).

22 2. On information and belief, this Court has personal jurisdiction over
23 Acella because Acella has maintained continuous and systematic contacts with the State
24 of Arizona, including by regularly and systematically conducting business in the State of
25 Arizona, such as by selling and offering to sell drug products in Arizona, and by selling
26 and offering to sell drug products to residents of Arizona, and by placing drug products
27 into interstate commerce for the purpose of selling or having them sold in Arizona.

2 the technology of the '355 Patent is responsible in significant part for that success.

3 **COUNT ONE**
4 **Patent Infringement**

5 10. Acella has offered for sale benzoyl peroxide foaming cloths in three
6 strengths: 3%, 6%, and 9%, each of which, according to Acella, "competes with"
7 Medicis's Triaz[®] Foaming Cloths. *See* Exhibit A.

8 11. Upon information and belief, the manufacture, sale and offer to sell
9 of Acella's benzoyl peroxide foaming cloths directly infringes the '355 Patent's claims.

10 **PRAYER FOR RELIEF**

11 WHEREFORE, Medicis prays the Court for the following relief:

12 A. That judgment be entered that Acella's manufacture, offer for sale,
13 and sale of Acella's benzoyl peroxide foaming cloths infringe the '355 Patent;

14 B. That a permanent injunction be issued under 35 U.S.C. § 271(e)
15 restraining or enjoining Acella, its officers, agents or attorneys or employees, and those
16 acting in privity or concert with it, from engaging in the manufacture, use, offer to sell, or
17 sale within the United States, or importation into the United States, of any products
18 covered by the '355 Patent for the full term thereof, and from inducing or contributing to
19 such activities;

20 C. That this is an exceptional case under 35 U.S.C. § 285 and that
21 judgment be entered for costs and reasonable attorney fees to be awarded to Medicis; and

22 D. That this Court award such other and further relief as the Court may
23 deem proper and just under the circumstances.
